On arrival you will need to register for a bidding number, this number will be unique to you and can be used for single or multiple purchases.

After viewing the sheep and having shortlisted your choice(s) you will need to confirm your bidding value to the McCartneys representative positioned by the pen board who will write your bidding number on the board next to the lots with the bid value. You will need to keep an eye on your bids, if you are outbid you will need to re-submit a new bid on the board. The McCartneys team will be providing help and advice for each pen of rams. All bids will be in guineas and in increments of 50 guineas for rams.

Payment (and movement licenses) will be processed by McCartneys.

Rams purchased can be taken home on the day, alternatively we are happy to hold rams on farm for 30 days post sale day until 30 August 2016. Insurance will be in place for the 30 day period whilst rams are held on the farm. We can arrange free delivery to mainland England and Wales at a convenient time to suit, and can discuss delivery options for further afield.

If you are unable to attend the Ram Sale we will accept telephone bids, or bids submitted in writing prior to sale. We will also have a SKYPE connection to assist with viewing.

Every ram presented at this year's sale has been sampled, which has provided us with valuable genetic data for future reference – our hope in time is that we can use this data to identify important production and disease traits within the flock, such as genetic worm resistance, susceptibility to mastitis, footrot, etc. For those clients who need to be assured of scrapie status, with the exception of one ram who failed to provide an adequate sample, all rams presented are ARR-ARR homozygous and are therefore eligible for export – in addition, the presence of the myostatin (double-muscling gene) is provided for every animal presented. We hope in years to come to be able to provide an increasing amount of genetic information with each ram to use alongside existing Signet performance figures to assist you in your choice."

Our objective under this new style of selling is to enable you to make your choice without the pressure of a traditional 'ring' auction, and to allow you time to find a suitable alternative, should you fail to secure your first choice.

With unrivalled accuracy levels on his performance indexes, you can purchase his progeny with confidence (stored frozen semen for UK & Europe also available).

#### **619:01079**

Reared as a twin on a ewe lamb (619:00115 – full blood sister to ram 091904), his mother managed to wean off 82kg of lamb in conjunction with his litter brother 619:01078! Sired by an extremely easy lambing sire bred by Jim Dufosse (940:060702), we used this ram extensively on ewe lambs, producing lively progeny with remarkable vigour at birth. This ram exhibits a higher than average fat ebv and we have used this attribute judiciously on those extra lean ewes whose progeny can run to heavy weights before they are adequately finished. The additional benefit of this sire is his undoubted genetic ability to pass on worm resistance traits, and currently boasts a FEC ebv well beyond the prescribed Top 1% at unprecedented accuracy (93%) allowing you to improve this trait in your replacement females without compromising performance.



### **619:01083**

This Incheoch Legend grandson, son of Moonshine (reared by ewe lamb 619:00246) has been used almost exclusively on ewe lambs. He exhibits easy-lambing traits alongside that vital 'get-up-and-go' in his lambs at birth. He's a very compact and well-balanced sheep which we feel has been adequately tested before being let loose on our nucleus flock females.

### **619:01331**

This ram represents our most impressive male progeny bred from our investment in to 621:100732. Displaying superb confirmation without compromising easy-lambing credentials, he boasts an enviable muscle depth EBV which in combination with tremendous growth potential gives rise to faster-finishing, shapely lambs. We would advise this ram's progeny are used where you need growth and confirmation without compromising the existing maternal characteristics of your foundation females.

### **599:1101697**

This purchased ram represents yet another significant investment, having been hand-picked on-farm in 2012, and secured with a private offer in 2012 from Flock 599. His progeny display a distinctive stamp – stylish, shapely, compact animals with impressive growth rates. He consistently produces lambs with exceptional natural worm resistance – each season his figures consolidate, and with accuracy values now above 90% range, this is once again a ram whose progeny can be selected and used with confidence.

Procured as ram lambs from Richard and Sue Evans, who have used some of our very best breeding lines over the last 15 years, since they established their extensive Lleyn flock in Norfolk. A grandson of our original homebred stock sire 619:091904 (see page 4), bred by Duncan Nelless within his Northumberland-based flock. He has successfully replicated the favourable maternal attributes of his grandfather, alongside extremely sound carcase characteristics and parasite resistance. Used in the autumn of 2017 on a selected group of nucleus ewes, this years' consignment of yearling rams will provide yet another option for returning purchasers.
